MEMBERSHIP- Mike Rieken. Our membership total is 118. Most of our newest members are already playing golf with us. They include the members profiled in Bios later in this report. Members are encouraged to inform their senior golfer friends that we welcome new members and have a full schedule of tournaments planned for the coming year. We plan to not schedule any days off and will have away tournaments once a month in Jan.-Oct. 2024. Our Club gets preferred tee times between 7am and 9am with senior rates, a benefit not offered to the general public.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP WINNERS: Congratulations to Chong Kang who won both Low Gross Club Champion and Low Net Champion in Flight A. Bob Bunes won Flight B Low Net, and Mike Rieken was the Flight C Low Net winner. All 3 will receive their prize awards at the Annual Meeting following golf on November 15.

SENIOR CUP PLAYOFFS- Playoffs were held on Monday, Oct. 23 and 25 with 28 qualifiers and alternates competing in a Two-Day Tournament, with Partner Better Ball matches on Day 1 and Singles Matches on Day 2. The two Senior Cup points leaders, Abe Manjikian and Brian Mason, served as Captains and set the lineup of the matches. Abe's team won the 2-Day playoff with 18 match points vs. 10 for Brian's team. The winning team will each receive Knollwood CC free play vouchers to be used in the next 12 months.

ANNUAL MEETING NOTICE- Our Annual Meeting and election of officers will be held following the November 15 Turkey Shoot golf tournament. This is a shotgun start which begins at 7am and is followed by a free burger lunch, presentations of Club Championship prizes, and officer elections. A slate of officer nominations will be presented, but individual members may be nominated for any of the elected officer positions. We also encourage all members to volunteer for open Board of Director positions, as our Club is only as successful as the contributions of our volunteers. A schedule of tournament events will be available, and we solicit all members to consider signing up to serve as Chairman for one or more tournaments. This is a good way to learn how tournaments are executed, and a chance to meet members who you do not yet know. All members are invited to attend and participate, even if you are not playing golf that day.

RULES OF GOLF- Pace of Play.

During the Club Championship (Oct. 2 and 4) there were two separate groups that were penalized a general penalty (2 strokes) for submitting their scorecards late (40 minutes behind the group ahead). KSMGC has had a policy for several years that established 20 minutes as the allowed time period to submit score cards between groups. That policy was modified earlier this year and

added a 10 minute "grace period" for a total of 30 minutes to turn in your scorecard. Note: this penalty will not be applied if your group is able to finish your round in 4 hours and 30 minutes.

In the Rules of Golf, player's edition, Rule 5.6 (a and b) explains the Rule for an individual to follow and provides for some procedures during play to maintain a reasonable pace-of-play. All members should be familiar with this Rule and follow its suggestions.

If a player(s) has a reason for being late, such as a failed cart or a sick player, then it is their responsibility to contact the Tournament Chairman, the Scorer, or a Board Member ASAP to explain why they are late. If there is no explanation provided, a penalty will be applied and added onto all of the scores of the entire group for Hole 18.

Dick Bratkovich: The October 4, 2023 Minutes were submitted and approved by the Board.

Gordon Seaberg (by phone): There is \$14,229.51 in the treasury. After potential deposits and payouts, the book balance is \$11,649.51. The year-end projected book balance is \$8,774.51. (Note: Later in the meeting, it was reported that a decision was made to not embellish the free burger lunch on 11/15/23. The savings will add \$1,125 to the year-end projected book balance.)

Handicap report: Bob Ensell is resigning as Handicap Chairman

Scoring report: Mike McGann is resigning as Scoring Chairman

Tom Oatway: The next Newsletter will be issued late this week. Next year, the Senior Cup match will have 24 players instead of 32. The matches will be held on two consecutive Wednesdays.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- NOMINATING COMMITTEE UPDATE: Hewitt Hornbeck will replace Bob Ensell on the "slate" of 2024 Officer candidates for the position of 2nd V.P. Handicap Chairman.
- 2024 TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE: (1) A motion was passed to have the July and August 2024 starting tee times at Knollwood set at 7:00 AM. (2) A decision was made to schedule a tournament the day before Thanksgiving. (If an insufficient number of players enter, the tee times will be used for open play. (3) A decision was made to change one of the March tournaments from Low net/Skins to 2-man Scramble (Rob Lindeen will chair this tournament.)
- WEBSITE FAQs: Dick Bratkovich created a draft update of the FAQs, except for the Handicap section. The document will be given to Board members to identify any errors or omissions.
- ANNUAL MEETING LUNCHEON: The free burger lunch to be held after the 11/15/23 shotgun start Turkey Shoot tournament will not have embellishments because of the high cost.

- BOARD GOLF OUTING NOVEMBER 6 @ STERLING HILLS: The first tee time is 8:12 AM. If all 16 available slots are not filled by Board members, available slots can be filled by incoming Board members or others who provided significant Club contributions during 2023.
